Automated Meter Reading (AMR) Installation

Fall Off the Bone Ribs

Take two sides of short ribs with the skin removed from the back side and rub in your favorite commercial or homemade rub on both sides. Wrap in plastic wrap and put in refrigerator for a minimum of two hours.

Preheat natural gas oven to 450°

Put rack inside a large, shallow roasting pan to keep ribs off bottom. Lay ribs across rack and fill pan with water under the ribs. Make sure the ribs are not touching the water. Cover tightly with aluminum foil and bake for 30 minutes at 450°. Turn the temperature down to 300° and allow ribs to cook slowly for at least four to six hours until the meat begins to fall off the bone.

Remove from natural gas oven and very carefully remove foil so that the steam safely escapes. Brush ribs generously with your favorite barbecue sauce and return to the oven to bake for 15 minutes. Carefully use tongs to lift ribs in one piece and place on platter.

HOME COMFORT TIP:

Nothing beats jumping into a hot shower after a long day, especially in the winter months when temperatures are at or below freezing outside. With gas water heaters heating water nearly twice as fast as electric there's no need to settle for a quick or lukewarm shower.
